| 25. | <b>HB61</b> | <b>JAY MORRIS</b> | <b>TAX/SALES &amp; USE</b> Dedicates the avails of the existing one percent state sales and use tax to the Stability in Higher Education Fund and provides with respect to the extent of that tax base for purposes of monies available for deposit into the fund (Items #7 and 36) |
| 26. | <b>HB62</b> | <b>JACKSON</b>    | <b>TAX/SALES-USE, STATE</b> Impose a one cent sales and use tax (Item #9)   |
| 27. | <b>HB64</b> | <b>MONTOUCET</b>  | <b>TAX/SALES-USE, ST-EXEMPT</b> Provides for the extent of the state sales and use tax exemption for business utilities (Items #9 and 36)   |
| 28. | <b>HB72</b> | <b>SHADOIN</b>    | <b>TAX/SALES-USE, STATE</b> Increases the state sales tax on telecommunications services (Item #24)   |
| 29. | <b>HB75</b> | <b>STOKES</b>     | <b>TAX/INCOME TAX</b> Changes the rates and brackets for purposes of calculating individual income tax liability and eliminates certain deductions (Item #3)  |

30. **HB76**      **STOKES**      **TAX/INCOME TAX** (Constitutional Amendment) Eliminates the income tax deduction for federal income taxes paid for purposes of computing individual and corporate income taxes and references to the maximum amount of individual income tax rates and brackets (Item #3)
31. **HB77**      **AMEDEE**      **FUNDS/FUNDING** Establishes the Payments Toward State Debt Fund as a special treasury fund (Item #7)
