House Concurrent Resolutions 2nd Reading

HCR 11 SCHRODER BUDGETARY CONTROLS

Creates the Task Force on Structural Change in Budget and Tax Policy to continue the budget and tax reform evaluations begun in the 2016 First Extraordinary Session and urges and requests the governor to support and implement initiatives for structural change introduced in upcoming sessions that will lead to savings through more efficient and effective state operations

Senate Bills 3rd Reading and Final Passage Subject to Call

SB 5 LAFLEUR TAX/TAXATION

Provides for the suspension of Louisiana Citizens Property Insurance Corporation assessment income tax credit. (gov sig)

SB 6 MORRELL TAX/AD VALOREM

Provides for the reduction of the amount of certain ad valorem tax credits and provides for the carryforward rather than the refund of a certain portion of excess credit amounts. (gov sig)

SB 18 MORRELL TAX EXEMPTIONS

Provides relative to sales and use tax exemption for rental or purchase of airplanes or airplane equipment and parts by Louisiana domiciled commuter airlines. (Item #36)(gov sig)

SB 19 MORRELL TAX EXEMPTIONS

Provides relative to the sales and use tax exemption for antique airplanes held by private collectors and not used for commercial purposes. (Item #36)(gov sig)

SB 21 MORRELL TAX EXEMPTIONS

Includes numismatic coins and bullion in the definition of tangible personal property subject to sales and use tax. (Item #36)(gov sig)

HB 2 BROADWATER TAX CREDITS

Repeals the Student Assessment for a Valuable Education (SAVE) credit program (Item #14)

HB 19 JAMES TAX/CORP FRANCHISE

Provides relative to the entities to which corporate franchise tax applies (Item #28)

HB 43 WHITE, MALINDA TAX/SALES & USE

Provides for the amount of vendors compensation authorized as compensation for the collection and remittance of state sales and use taxes (Item #21)

HB 54 BROADWATER TAX/SALES & USE

Requires the advance payment of sales tax (Item #35)

HB 55 LEGER TAX/INCOME TAX

Requires that certain deductible items be added-back on certain corporate income tax returns (Item #5)

HB 87 ANDERS TAX/INSURANCE PREMIUM

Reduces the amount of the insurance premium tax for certain Louisiana investments (Item #6)

HB 99 STOKES TAX/CORP INCOME

Provides relative to the apportionment ratio for purposes of computing corporate income tax (Item #5)

HB 116 IVEY TAX/CORP INCOME

Provides relative to loss years for purposes of the net operating loss deduction for corporate income tax (Item #5)

HB 59 MORENO TAX/SALES-USE, STATE

Provides relative to imposition of the state sales and use tax on hotels (Items #9 and 30)

HB 62 JACKSON TAX/SALES-USE, STATE

Impose a one cent sales and use tax (Item #9)

HB 122 HENRY APPROPRIATIONS/SUPPLEML

Supplemental appropriations and reductions in appropriations for Fiscal Year 2015-2016 (Item #1)
