Provides for an annual cap and a termination date for the musical and theatrical production income tax credit. (7/1/17)

Sunsets the individual income tax education credit. (gov sig)

SB 27 MORRELL TAX EXEMPTIONS  
Constitutional amendment to exempt diapers and feminine hygiene products from state sales and use tax. (2/3 - CA13s1(A))

Eliminates sunset provision on credit for taxes paid in other states. (gov sig)
