HOUSE BILLS ON FINAL PASSAGE - [17 items]

1. **HB90** **TALBOT** **CAPITAL OUTLAY** Requires certain legislative committees to approve line of credit recommendations for nonstate entity projects
2. **HB122** **DEVILLIER** **CAPITAL OUTLAY** Provides relative to capital outlay reform
3. **HB129** **REYNOLDS** **CAPITAL OUTLAY** Exempts certain Department of Wildlife and Fisheries projects from the capital outlay process
4. **HB132** **ZERINGUE** **CAPITAL OUTLAY** Provides relative to the local match requirements for nonstate entities applying for capital outlay funding
5. **HB146** **DAVIS** **CAPITAL OUTLAY** Defines "economic development project" for purposes of a late approval recommendation from the secretary of the Dept. of Economic Development
6. **HB175** **JAMES** **TAX/TAX REBATES** Authorizes a rebate for taxpayers who donate to certain higher education scholarship and grant programs
7. **HB250** **S.BISHOP** **TAX/AD VALOREM TAX** Changes requirements for newspaper advertisement of a public notice for a hearing concerning an increase in a property tax without voter approval
8. **HB312** **ABRAHAM** **TAX CREDITS** Prohibits certain types of productions from being eligible for the motion picture production tax credit
9. **HB375** **ABRAMSON** **TAX/TAX REBATES** Changes eligibility requirements for the Quality Jobs Program for employers in parishes with relatively low per capita income
10. **HB7** **G.MILLER** **ETHICS/CODE** Provides relative to certain statements required to be filed by elected officials
11. **HB45** **CONNICK** **LICENSING** Requires third-party logistics providers to obtain controlled dangerous substance licenses
12. **HB48** **CARPENTER** **PUBLIC BLDGS/GROUNDS-ST** Names the baseball operational center at Southern University in Baton Rouge in honor of Roger Cador
13. **HB51** **LEBAS** **ETHICS/DUAL OFFICEHOLDG** Provides an exception from dual officeholding laws to allow a certified public accountant to hold an office on a school board and employment with a sheriff to provide financial or accounting services
14. **HB53** **TALBOT** **ETHICS/CODE** Prohibits public servants in state government from engaging in certain activities with public funds and assets
15. **HB74** **DAVIS** **STUDENTS** Requires schools to provide information relative to influenza and immunization against the influenza virus

16. **HB85** **JAMES** **ETHICS/FINANCIAL DISCLOS** Exempts board members of a neighborhood security and improvement district from Tier 2.1 financial disclosure requirements
17. **HB86** **JAMES** **ETHICS** Provides an ethics exception to allow governing authority members and employees of a political subdivision or special district that operates parks and recreation facilities and the immediate family members of such persons to rent a facility for an event subject to certain conditions

4. **HB151** **LEBAS** **PHARMACISTS** Revises the definition of "approved college of pharmacy" as used in the La. Pharmacy Practice Act
5. **HB154** **MAGEE** **CHILDREN/SUPPORT** Provides relative to access to certain information for purposes of child support enforcement
6. **HB156** **BACALA** **MEDICAID** Provides relative to the task force on coordination of Medicaid fraud detection and prevention initiatives
7. **HB169** **TALBOT** **INSURANCE** Provides for notice of the cancellation of an insurance policy
8. **HB176** **LEGER** **STUDENTS** Requires students who are entering eleventh grade or who are 16 and entering any grade to provide satisfactory evidence of current immunization against meningococcal disease as a condition of school entry
9. **HB182** **JOHNSON** **CHILDRENS CODE** Provides relative to the Indian Child Welfare Act
10. **HB183** **N.LANDRY** **SUNSET LAW** Re-creates the Department of Education
11. **HB206** **ANDERS** **INSURANCE COMMISSIONER** Permits the employment of a convicted felon in the business of insurance in certain circumstances
12. **HB247** **HUVAL** **INSURANCE/SURPLUS LINE** Provides relative to types of coverage available under surplus lines insurance
13. **HB267** **ANDERS** **INSURANCE** Provides relative to prohibited acts for insurers and insurance producers
14. **HB294** **P.SMITH** **STUDENTS** Changes references to "at-risk" students to students who are "economically disadvantaged" throughout Title 17 of the Louisiana Revised Statutes
15. **HB326** **HENSGENS** **LEGISLATION** Makes technical corrections to various provisions of law within the purview of the legislative committees on health and welfare
16. **HB330** **JORDAN** **INSURANCE** Provides for insurance producer precicensing program requirements
