HRs AND HCRs FINAL CONSIDERATION - [5 items]

1. **HR13** **JAMES** **LAW ENFORCEMENT** Establishes a study group to study law enforcement systems and policing
2. **HCR5** **FREEMAN** **LEGISLATIVE AFFAIRS** Requests a study of the continuity of government provisions by the house and senate governmental affairs committees, meeting jointly
3. **HCR6** **WRIGHT** **U.S. CONSTITUTION** Calls for a convention to amend the United States Constitution to establish a limitation on terms for members of congress
4. **HCR8** **JAMES** **JOINT RULES** Requires all fiscal notes to be requested via email and requires the name of the person who requested the fiscal note to appear on the face of the fiscal note
5. **HCR11** **FONTENOT** **COASTAL RES/COASTAL ZONE**
Memorializes the U.S. Congress and the Louisiana congressional delegation to remove the revenue sharing cap on the Gulf of Mexico Energy Securities Act of 2006 for Gulf producing states and to take such actions as are necessary to rectify the federal revenue sharing inequities between energy producing states

HOUSE BILLS ON FINAL PASSAGE - [7 items]

1. **HB11** **STEFANSKI** **TAX/SALES & USE** Provides for the amount of compensation persons required to collect state sales and use tax may deduct for remitting taxes (Item #30)
2. **HB13** **WRIGHT** **TAX CREDITS** Authorizes certain retail businesses to participate in the Enterprise Zone incentive (Item #18)
3. **HB17** **BISHOP** **TAX/CORP FRANCHISE** Suspends the corporation franchise tax levied on certain taxable capital and suspends the initial corporation franchise tax levied on certain entities (Item #16)
4. **HB19** **PRESSLY** **TAX/TAX REBATES** Extends eligibility requirements for certain industries to participate in the Quality Jobs Program (Item #18)
5. **HB28** **DWIGHT** **TAX/AD VALOREM TAX** Authorizes agreements between political subdivisions and taxpayers that may provide for certain payments in lieu of ad valorem taxes (Item #28)
6. **HB35** **BISHOP** **FUNDS/FUNDING** Creates the Capital Outlay Savings Fund (Items #10 and #11)
7. **HB37** **LANCE HARRIS** **REVENUE DEPARTMENT** Requires the Department of Revenue to waive penalties and interest for certain taxpayers for tax years 2019 and 2020 (Item #29)

1. **HB34** **ECHOLS** **FUNDS/FUNDING** Creates the Louisiana Opioid Settlement Fund (Item #11)
2. **HB43** **GAROFALO** **CIVIL/ACTIONS** Makes revisions to the Omnibus Premium Reduction Act of 2020 (Item #40)

HRs AND HCRs FINAL CONSIDERATION - [4 items]

1. **HR24** **WHEAT** **COASTAL RES/WETLANDS** Urges and requests the Coastal Protection and Restoration Authority to work with the Department of Wildlife and Fisheries to develop integrated coastal protection projects aimed at preserving and maintaining healthy estuarine and essential fish habitat in and around Lake Pontchartrain
2. **HCR10** **BAGLEY** **SCHOOLS/BUS OPERATORS** Requests governing authorities of public schools to continue operational pay for school bus operators during emergencies
3. **HCR12** **GAROFALO** **WORKFORCE DEVELOPMENT** Directs the Louisiana Workforce Investment Council to study and submit a report to the legislature relative to funding and programs for workforce development
4. **HCR16** **BOURRIQUE** **FUNDS/FUNDING** Memorializes Congress and the Louisiana congressional delegation to clarify the eligibility of freshwater fisheries impacted by the COVID-19 pandemic to receive CARES Act dollars

HOUSE BILLS ON FINAL PASSAGE - [10 items]

1. **HB14** **SCHEXNAYDER** **TAX/SALES & USE** (Constitutional Amendment) Authorizes the legislature to provide by law for the collection of sales and use taxes levied within the state (Item #27)
2. **HB16** **ECHOLS** **TAX CREDITS** Establishes a tax credit for eligible expenses incurred in the rehabilitation of historic structures included on the National Register of Historic Places (Item #19)
3. **HB23** **DWIGHT** **TAX/AD VALOREM TAX** (Constitutional Amendment) Authorizes certain agreements that provide for payments in lieu of ad valorem taxes (Item #28)
4. **HB26** **ZERINGUE** **COLLEGES/UNIVERSITIES** Extends, with limitations, the authority of public postsecondary education management boards to establish and increase student fees (Item #41)
5. **HB36** **IVEY** **TAX/AD VALOREM-EXEMPTION** (Constitutional Amendment) Establishes certain property tax exemptions for capital investment projects (Item #28)
6. **HB41** **IVEY** **TAX/AD VALOREM TAX** (Constitutional Amendment) Establishes an ad valorem tax exemption for capital investment projects and for certain property subject to a cooperative endeavor agreement requiring the property owner to make payments in lieu of taxes (Item #28)

7. **HB50** **IVEY** **TAX/AD VALOREM TAX** Authorizes local taxing authorities to enter into cooperative endeavor agreements that provide for payments in lieu of taxes (Item #28)

8. **HB52** **COUSSAN** **TAX CREDITS** Increases the amount of the Digital Interactive Media and Software Tax Credit, requires the increase to be used for training employees from certain disadvantaged groups, and expands eligibility to include information technology services (Item #19)

9. **HB54** **IVEY** **TAX/AD VALOREM-EXEMPTION** Provides for ad valorem tax exemptions for certain capital investment projects (Item # 28)

10. **HB64** **STEFANSKI** **TAX/GAMING** Levies a state tax on the net revenue of fantasy sports contests (Item #17)
