HRs AND HCRs FINAL CONSIDERATION - [1 items]

1. **HR46** **JAMES** **UNEMPLOYMENT COMP** Requests the Louisiana Workforce Commission to promote access to unemployment insurance benefits by improving wait times for filing claims

SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTIONS FINAL CONSIDERATION - [3 items]

1. **SCR11** **REESE** **EMPLOYMENT** Urges and requests certain state agencies and private businesses in Louisiana to recognize the value that justice-involved persons can bring to the workforce and society and to act with intention to empower, train, and employ such individuals.
2. **SCR13** **TROY CARTER** **WORKFORCE COMMISSION** Requests the Louisiana Workforce Commission to distribute information regarding the provisions of the Families First Coronavirus Response Act that provides paid sick time to employees who are unable to work due to the effects of COVID-19.
3. **SCR19** **CATHEY** **LEGIS POWERS/FUNCTIONS** Creates the Louisiana Sales Tax Simplification Task Force to develop a comprehensive plan to simplify Louisiana's sales tax administration and collection system.

2. **HCR17** **CARPENTER** **EMPLOYMENT** Requests certain state agencies and private businesses to recognize the value that justice-involved persons bring to the workforce and society, and to act with the intention to empower, train, and employ such individuals
3. **HCR7** **IVEY** **LEGISLATIVE AGCY/LAW INST** Directs the Louisiana State Law Institute to study the Constitution of Louisiana and make recommendations to the legislature regarding transitional and outdated language that can be removed or changed without affecting the effect of the constitutional provisions

5. **HB29** **ZERINGUE** **APPROPRIATIONS/SUPPLEML** Makes supplemental appropriations for Fiscal Year 2019-2020 (Item #2)
6. **HB35** **BISHOP** **FUNDS/FUNDING** Creates the Capital Outlay Savings Fund (Items #10 and #11)
7. **HB44** **GAROFALO** **INSURANCE/AUTOMOBILE** Enacts the Omnibus Premium Reduction Act of 2020 (Item #40)
8. **HB55** **MIKE JOHNSON** **MTR VEHICLE/SEAT BELTS** Provides relative to evidence of causation from nonuse of a safety belt (Item #40)
9. **HB62** **ZERINGUE** **UNEMPLOYMENT COMP** Provides for state income tax withholdings on unemployment compensation benefits (Item #32)
10. **HB69** **DESHOTEL** **TAX/SALES-USE-EXEMPT** To provide for a sales and use tax exemption on the sale of certain fiber-optic cables (Item #31)
11. **HB70** **JENKINS** **TAX/TAX REBATES** Extends Enterprise Zone Program incentives to essential critical infrastructure workers by authorizing the payment of a one-time hazard pay rebate (Item #18)
