HRs AND HCRs FINAL CONSIDERATION - [28 items]

1. **HR20** **EDMONDS** **CONSUMERS/PROTECTION** Urges and requests Attorney General Jeff Landry to ensure a swift, effective, and unified response to price gouging
2. **HR21** **LANCE HARRIS** **RETIREMENT BENEFITS** Requests the state retirement systems to provide information to the legislature regarding permanent benefit increases for retirees.
3. **HCR2** **MAGEE** **CRIMINAL/JUSTICE** Suspends certain provisions of the Code of Criminal Procedure relative to financial obligations of criminal offenders
4. **HCR4** **BEAULLIEU** **TAX/AD VALOREM-EXEMPTION** Amends rules relative to participation in the Industrial Tax Exemption Program
5. **HCR8** **BEAULLIEU** **BUDGETARY CONTROLS** Reduces the expenditure limit for FY 2020-2021
6. **HCR9** **MIKE JOHNSON** **CONGRESS** Memorializes Congress to support the Social Security Fairness Act
7. **HCR14** **MOORE** **CRIMINAL/JUSTICE** Directs the Department of Public Safety and Corrections, the Louisiana Department of Health, and the Louisiana Department of Education to study the barriers that impede successful reintegration of offenders back into society
8. **HCR31** **EDMONDS** **TAX/SALES & USE** Suspends provision of law capping amount of revenue which can be spent on in-state advertising
9. **HCR58** **MIGUEZ** **GOVERNOR** Suspends certain provisions of Title 29 of the La. Revised Statutes relative to public emergencies
10. **HR19** **ZERINGUE** **COASTAL RESOURCES** Approves the annual state integrated coastal protection plan for Fiscal Year 2021, as adopted by the Coastal Protection and Restoration Authority Board
11. **HCR6** **EDMONDS** **LEGISLATIVE COMMITTEES** Creates and provides for the Joint Medicaid Oversight Committee
12. **HCR20** **MALINDA WHITE** **SCHOOLS/BUS OPERATORS** Requests that the State Bd. of Elementary and Secondary Education study the compensation schedule for school bus operators
13. **HCR25** **GREGORY MILLER** **CIVIL/ACTIONS** Provides for the suspension of all civil prescriptive, peremptive, filing, and other deadlines in response to the COVID-19 Public Health Emergency declared by the governor
14. **HCR28** **WRIGHT** **U.S. CONSTITUTION** Calls for a convention to amend the United States Constitution to establish a limitation on terms for members of congress

15. **HCR33** **FREIBERG** **EDUCATION** Requests the Board of Regents, Department of Revenue, Louisiana Workforce Commission, and office of student financial assistance to collaborate to study the trajectory of Louisiana's postsecondary graduates
16. **HCR48** **WRIGHT** **ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEDURE** Requests the House and Senate governmental affairs committees to meet and function as a joint committee to review the process of rulemaking by state agencies and the Louisiana Administrative Code and make recommendations relative thereto
17. **HCR52** **ECHOLS** **HEALTH CARE/RECORDS** Requests a report on actions by the La. Dept. of Health and Medicaid managed care organizations to comply with federal rules on interoperability of health records and patient access to health information
18. **HCR57** **MCFARLAND** **MEDICAID** Requests the La. Department of Health to issue regular reports of data on Medicaid enrollees with private insurance or offers of employer-sponsored health coverage
19. **HCR65** **BISHOP** **TAX/SEVERANCE TAX** Suspends the severance taxes levied on oil, natural gas, distillate, and condensate
20. **HCR66** **BISHOP** **TAX/CORP FRANCHISE** Suspends the lower tier of the corporation franchise tax levied on domestic and foreign corporations and the initial tax levied on certain business entities subject to the corporate franchise tax
21. **HCR70** **SCHEXNAYDER** **CONGRESS** Expresses support for the State and Municipal Aid for Recovery and Transition (SMART) Fund, proposed for the purpose of helping states and local governments respond to the current public health and economic crisis
22. **HCR71** **SCHEXNAYDER** **LICENSING** Authorizes and directs suspension of licensing fees imposed on businesses by state agencies and licensing boards
23. **HCR73** **SCHEXNAYDER** **HEALTH** Requests an update from the Louisiana Department of Health and the division of administration on efforts to establish an application or system to track the incidence and spread of COVID-19
24. **HCR74** **SCHEXNAYDER** **HEALTH** Requests that CARES Act funding be made available to the state for testing and be distributed to healthcare systems
25. **HCR76** **WRIGHT** **TAX/CORP INCOME** Urges and requests that any proclamation convening an extraordinary session of the legislature in 2020 include changes to the carryback provisions of the corporate income tax deduction for net operating losses
26. **HCR77** **SCHEXNAYDER** **COMMERCE** Urges and requests removal of public and private sector barriers to accelerate the expansion of broadband in the state

27. **HCR78** **SCHEXNAYDER** **COMMERCE** Provides relative to Louisiana broadband maps to identify access and activation gaps
