- SCR 55 HEWITT VOTERS/VOTING
Establishes the Closed Party Primary Task Force to study the necessary steps to develop a closed party primary election system applicable at the federal, state, and local levels beginning with the 2022 congressional elections.
- SCR 56 HEWITT FISH/FISHING
Requests CPRA and the Dept. of Wildlife and Fisheries to cooperate in developing projects and programs to enhance the oyster industry.

Senate Bills 3rd Reading and Final Passage

- SB 80 CARTER, TROY SCHOOLS
Exempts interior blueprints and floor plans of public school buildings and facilities from the definition of "public records". (gov sig)

| SB | 180 | MORRIS, JAY | FEES/LICENSES/PERMITS | Provides qualifications and licensing requirements for title insurance producers. (8/1/20) |
| SB | 183 | HARRIS, JIMMY | ELECTION DAYS | Authorizes clerks of court to have law enforcement officers at polling places on election day to enforce law and authorizes law enforcement officers to enter voting location in an emergency. (gov sig) |
| SB | 202 | TALBOT | INSURANCE POLICIES | Provides for health insurance coverage for participants in clinical trials. (8/1/20) |
| SB | 204 | TALBOT | INSURANCE POLICIES | Provides for health insurance coverage of cancer treatments. (gov sig) |
| SB | 271 | JOHNS | HEALTH/ACC INSURANCE | Provides relative to the Health Care Consumer Billing and Disclosure Protection Act. (8/1/20) |
| SB | 293 | JACKSON | EDUCATION ACCOUNTABILITY | Limits the use of certain test scores in the school accountability system. (gov sig) |
| SB | 299 | JACKSON | INSURANCE RATES | Prohibits insurers from using certain criteria for rate setting. (8/1/20) |
| SB | 318 | CATHEY | TOPS | Provides for TOPS-Tech award eligibility for certain military veterans. (gov sig) |
| SB | 365 | CLOUD | STUDENTS | Requires that information be provided to students about high demand jobs during the development and revision of their individual graduation plans. (gov sig) |
| SB | 373 | CLOUD | INSURERS | Revises time period in which insurer must provide an insured loss claims history upon request. (8/1/20) |
| SB | 437 | JACKSON | COLLEGES/UNIVERSITIES | Provides relative to postsecondary education management board sick leave policies. (gov sig) |
| SB | 466 | HEWITT | PUBLIC MEETINGS | Provides for teleconferencing of public bodies under certain circumstances. (gov sig) |
| SB | 477 | WARD | INSURANCE POLICIES | Provides relative to business interruption insurance. (gov sig) |
| SB | 506 | BARROW | PROPERTY INSURANCE | Authorizes property insurance policies insuring commercial and residential buildings to cover cost of disinfecting fumigation. (gov sig) |
| SB | 517 | FIELDS | WORKERS' COMPENSATION | Provides for continuation of the weekly death benefit for the surviving spouse of a law enforcement officer upon remarriage. (8/1/20) |

- SB 168 MILLS, FRED WATER QUALITY
Creates and provides for the Community Drinking Water Infrastructure Sustainability Act. (8/1/20)
- SB 188 WHITE, B CRIME/PUNISHMENT
Designates the crime of possession of a firearm by a felon as a "crime of violence". (gov sig)
- SB 189 WHITE, B FUNDS/FUNDING
Provides for the creation, transfer, dedication, deposit, and use of certain funds in the state treasury. (7/1/20)
- SB 272 ABRAHAM TAX EXEMPTIONS
Constitutional amendment to establish an ad valorem tax exemption for property subject to a cooperative endeavor agreement requiring the property owner to make payments in lieu of taxes. (2/3 - CA13s1(A))
- SB 434 MIZELL CRIMINAL JUSTICE
Provides for immunity from prosecution and post-conviction relief for victims of human trafficking. (gov sig)
- SB 471 MILLS, ROBERT CIVIL PROCEDURE
Provides for the Louisiana Timber Transportation and Safety Act. (8/1/20)
