**Senate Resolutions 2nd Reading**

- SR 45 HEWITT SENATE  
Amends Senate rules to permit members to vote via video or other electronic means during a declared emergency.
- SR 46 HENRY, CAMERON CORONERS  
Creates the Coroner Safety Task Force to develop policy recommendations that seek to enhance the prevention and mitigation of harm against a coroner and behavioral health facility personnel.

- HB 6 MILLER, G. STATE AGENCIES  
Provides relative to reports by executive branch agencies
- HB 29 BACALA CHILDREN/MISSING  
Provides relative to the reporting duties of law enforcement with respect to information about missing children
- HB 57 MUSCARELLO CRIMINAL/JURY TRIALS  
Provides for the functions of the jury commission in Tangipahoa Parish
- HB 65 DWIGHT CRIME  
Provides relative to exceptions to the crime of political payroll padding by a sheriff
- HB 77 DEVILLIER PARDON/PAROLE  
Provides relative to the supervision and reporting requirements of persons on probation or parole
- HB 89 JAMES DRUGS/CONTROLLED  
Adds certain substances to the Uniform Controlled Dangerous Substances Law
- HB 97 LACOMBE CAPITAL OUTLAY  
Removes certain limitations on the exemption from local match requirements for certain rural water system projects
- HB 110 MILLER, G. ELECTIONS/CANDIDATES  
Provides relative to methods of service of process regarding actions objecting to candidacy and contesting an election
- HB 111 DESHOTEL PUBLIC PROPERTY  
Authorizes the Red River, Atchafalaya, and Bayou Beouf Levee Districts to exchange property in Avoyelles Parish
- HB 164 DAVIS HEALTH/EMERG MED SERVICE  
Provides relative to emergency medical services protocols in certain life-threatening situations
- HB 181 RISER WATER/RESOURCES  
Extends cooperative endeavor agreements for use of surface waters
- HB 184 VILLIO PROPERTY/PUBLIC  
Provides for the lease of certain state property in Jefferson Parish
- HB 202 HORTON REVENUE DEPARTMENT  
Provides that the reports, studies, and recommended publications of the Louisiana Tax Institute shall be distributed by the Department of Revenue rather than the Department of State and provides for the membership of the board of the Institute
- HB 220 JOHNSON, MIKE CONTRACTORS  
Provides relative to the judicial enforcement of fines and penalties assessed by the state licensing board for contractors
- HB 284 DAVIS BANKS/BANKING  
Provides relative to financial institutions
- HB 412 ZERINGUE FUNDS/FUNDING  
Expands the authorized uses of monies in the State Emergency Response Fund
- HB 442 MCFARLAND TRANSPORTATION  
Provides relative to timber harvest season permits

- HB 477 IVEY PURCHASING/PROCUREMENT CD  
Provides relative to technology procurement
- HB 514 WILLARD TRANSPORTATION  
Provides relative to electric-assisted bicycles
- HB 583 MINCEY TRUSTS/PUBLIC  
Requires certain public trusts to obtain approval of a parish or municipal governing authority under certain circumstances prior to undertaking an authorized public function or purpose
- HB 607 HODGES MTR VEHICLE/DRIVER LIC  
Provides relative to documentation required for certain driver's licenses
- HB 691 LYONS ENVIRONMENT  
Reinstates the Brownfields Cleanup Revolving Loan Fund and program
- HB 736 CARTER, GARY TAX  
Authorizes the Louisiana Tax Commission to order the refund of statutory impositions declared invalid
- HB 758 ZERINGUE PUBLIC CONTRACTS  
Provides relative to payments under public contract

- SB 418 TALBOT LIABILITY INSURANCE  
Enacts the Omnibus Premium Reduction Act of 2020. (1/1/21)

- SB 359 HENSGENS COASTAL RESOURCES  
Provides for the enforcement of coastal use permits. (gov sig)

**Special Order No. 3 for 05/18.**

- SCR 7 HEWITT COASTAL RESOURCES  
To urge and request certain officials and local governments to dismiss coastal lawsuits.

**Senate Bills 3rd Reading and Final Passage**

- SB 80 CARTER, TROY SCHOOLS  
Exempts interior blueprints and floor plans of public school buildings and facilities from the definition of "public records". (gov sig)
- SB 104 MILLIGAN MUSEUMS  
Provides for board membership and authority of certain state museums. (gov sig)
- SB 156 LUNEAU INSURERS  
Prohibits insurance contracts from depriving courts of this state of the jurisdiction or venue of action against insurer. (8/1/20)
- SB 202 TALBOT INSURANCE POLICIES  
Provides for health insurance coverage for participants in clinical trials. (8/1/20)
- SB 204 TALBOT INSURANCE POLICIES  
Provides for health insurance coverage of cancer treatments. (gov sig)
- SB 293 JACKSON EDUCATION ACCOUNTABILITY  
Limits the use of certain test scores in the school accountability system. (gov sig)
- SB 299 JACKSON INSURANCE RATES  
Prohibits insurers from using certain criteria for rate setting. (8/1/20)
- SB 318 CATHEY TOPS  
Provides for TOPS-Tech award eligibility for certain military veterans. (gov sig)
- SB 365 CLOUD STUDENTS  
Requires that information be provided to students about high demand jobs during the development and revision of their individual graduation plans. (gov sig)

- SB 437 JACKSON COLLEGES/UNIVERSITIES  
Provides relative to postsecondary education management board sick leave policies. (gov sig)
- SB 466 HEWITT PUBLIC MEETINGS  
Provides for teleconferencing of public bodies under certain circumstances. (gov sig)
- SB 477 WARD INSURANCE POLICIES  
Provides relative to business interruption insurance. (gov sig)
- SB 506 BARROW PROPERTY INSURANCE  
Authorizes property insurance policies insuring commercial and residential buildings to cover cost of disinfecting fumigation. (gov sig)
- SB 440 FESI COASTAL RESOURCES  
Provides for enforcement of the Coastal Zone Management Program. (8/1/20)

**Senate Bills 3rd Reading and Final Passage Subject to Call**

- SB 67 MILLS, FRED HEALTH CARE  
Provides for the repeal of certain inactive or obsolete laws. (8/1/20)
- SB 69 BOUDREAUX SECRETARY OF STATE  
Authorizes the secretary of state to refer matters involving the damaging, altering, tampering, or of falsifying records to certain agencies for investigation. (gov sig)
- SB 105 PEACOCK LEGIS POWERS/FUNCTIONS  
Designates the Gulf Fritillary as the official state butterfly. (8/1/20)
- SB 168 MILLS, FRED WATER QUALITY  
Creates and provides for the Community Drinking Water Infrastructure Sustainability Act. (8/1/20)
- SB 188 WHITE, B CRIME/PUNISHMENT  
Designates the crime of possession of a firearm by a felon as a "crime of violence". (gov sig)
- SB 189 WHITE, B FUNDS/FUNDING  
Provides for the creation, transfer, dedication, deposit, and use of certain funds in the state treasury. (7/1/20)
- SB 272 ABRAHAM TAX EXEMPTIONS  
Constitutional amendment to establish an ad valorem tax exemption for property subject to a cooperative endeavor agreement requiring the property owner to make payments in lieu of taxes. (2/3 - CA13s1(A))
- SB 434 MIZELL CRIMINAL JUSTICE  
Provides for immunity from prosecution and post-conviction relief for victims of human trafficking. (gov sig)
- SB 443 WARD ADVERTISING  
Prohibits certain advertising costs from being passed on to clients or customers. (8/1/20)
- SB 471 MILLS, ROBERT CIVIL PROCEDURE  
Provides for the Louisiana Timber Transportation and Safety Act. (8/1/20)
