HB 114 BAGLEY ELECTIONS
Provides relative to parish boards of election supervisors

HB 131 FIRMENT INSURANCE CLAIMS
Provides relative to covered claims of the Louisiana Insurance Guaranty Association

HB 158 MARINO MEDICAL MARIJUANA
Authorizes the recommendation of medical marijuana in treating certain neurodegenerative diseases and conditions

HB 159 MCFARLAND WILDLIFE & FISHERIES
Allows nighttime hunting of outlaw quadrupeds, nutria, and beaver on private property at any time of the year

HB 167 EMERSON ELECTIONS/PRESIDENTIAL
Provides relative to the submission of nominees for the offices of president and vice president

HB 246 COUSSAN HUNTING/LICENSES
Authorizes the secretary of the Department of Wildlife and Fisheries to certify "organizations involved in charitable hunting and fishing activities" and waives license fees for such organizations

HB 290 BISHOP, S. ELECTIONS/COMMISSIONERS
Prohibits the disclosure of addresses and telephone numbers of election commissioners

HB 296 ILLG INSURANCE/POLICIES
Provides for cancellation of a policy by the insured party

HB 312 MILLER, D. DENTISTRY/DENTISTS
Exempts retired volunteer dentists from continuing education requirements

HB 330 LYONS HEALTH/MEDICAL TREATMENT
Adds chronic pain associated with fibromyalgia to the set of conditions qualifying a patient for treatment with medical marijuana

HB 343 JORDAN INSURERS/AGENTS
Provides relative to the Bail Bond Apprentice Program

HB 409 LACOMBE SCHOOLS/BOARDS
Provides with respect to purchasing by school boards

HB 411 RISER HUNTING/LICENSES
Provides relative to hunting and fishing license fees for Purple Heart recipients

HB 421 BROWN, CHAD INSURANCE
Provides relative to bail bond enforcement

Provides for the repeal of certain inactive or obsolete laws. (8/1/20)
- SB 69 BOUDREAUX SECRETARY OF STATE
Authorizes the secretary of state to refer matters involving the damaging, altering, tampering, or of falsifying records to certain agencies for investigation. (gov sig)
- SB 105 PEACOCK LEGIS POWERS/FUNCTIONS
Designates the Gulf Fritillary as the official state butterfly. (8/1/20)
- SB 168 MILLS, FRED WATER QUALITY
Creates and provides for the Community Drinking Water Infrastructure Sustainability Act. (8/1/20)
- SB 202 TALBOT INSURANCE POLICIES
Provides for health insurance coverage for participants in clinical trials. (8/1/20)

Prohibits certain advertising costs from being passed on to clients or customers. (8/1/20)

Provides for the Louisiana Timber Transportation and Safety Act. (8/1/20)

Provides relative to security for deposits required by certain entities

Reestablishes the Louisiana Toxic Mold Task Force
- HB 682 FRIEMAN INSURANCE
Provides relative to reserves for insurers

Provides relative to life safety and property protection and conveyance device mechanic licenses
- HB 722 MILLER, G. FINANCIAL INSTITUTIONS
Provides for the enforcement of electronic signatures by financial institutions

Authorizes public bodies to allow members to participate and vote electronically during certain states of emergency subject to certain conditions

Provides for premium discounts on motor vehicle insurance when an insured consents to have data provided to third parties

Authorizes the recommendation of medical marijuana for additional conditions and allows any state-licensed physician to recommend medical marijuana
