- SR 61 MCMATH CONDOLENCES  
Expresses condolences upon the death of Jesse Lee Wimberly IV.
- SR 62 PETERSON CONDOLENCES  
Expresses condolences on the death of Terrebonne Parish educator and pioneer, Dr. James Edward Charles.

**Senate Bills 3rd Reading and Final Passage Subject to Call**

- SB 67 MILLS, FRED HEALTH CARE  
Provides for the repeal of certain inactive or obsolete laws. (8/1/20)
- SB 69 BOUDREAUX SECRETARY OF STATE  
Authorizes the secretary of state to refer matters involving the damaging, altering, tampering, or of falsifying records to certain agencies for investigation. (gov sig)
- SB 105 PEACOCK LEGIS POWERS/FUNCTIONS  
Designates the Gulf Fritillary as the official state butterfly. (8/1/20)
- SB 168 MILLS, FRED WATER QUALITY  
Creates and provides for the Community Drinking Water Infrastructure Sustainability Act. (8/1/20)
- SB 202 TALBOT INSURANCE POLICIES  
Provides for health insurance coverage for participants in clinical trials. (8/1/20)
- SB 293 JACKSON EDUCATION ACCOUNTABILITY  
Limits the use of certain test scores in the school accountability system. (gov sig)
- SB 299 JACKSON INSURANCE RATES  
Prohibits insurers from using certain criteria for rate setting. (8/1/20)
- SB 359 HENSGENS COASTAL RESOURCES  
Provides for the enforcement of coastal use permits. (gov sig)
- SB 434 MIZELL CRIMINAL JUSTICE  
Provides for immunity from prosecution and post-conviction relief for victims of human trafficking. (gov sig)
- SB 443 WARD ADVERTISING  
Prohibits certain advertising costs from being passed on to clients or customers. (8/1/20)
- SB 471 MILLS, ROBERT CIVIL PROCEDURE  
Provides for the Louisiana Timber Transportation and Safety Act. (8/1/20)

**House Concurrent Resolutions Reported by Committee to be adopted**

- HCR 14 MOORE CRIMINAL/JUSTICE  
Directs the Department of Public Safety and Corrections, the Louisiana Department of Health, and the Louisiana Department of Education to study the barriers that impede successful reintegration of offenders back into society
- HCR 25 MILLER, G. CIVIL/ACTIONS  
Provides for the suspension of all civil prescriptive, peremptive, filing, and other deadlines in response to the COVID-19 Public Health Emergency declared by the governor
- HCR 56 BAGLEY CRIME  
Requests the study of homicide offenses in Louisiana with respect to the offender's prior criminal history
- HCR 60 KERNER CONGRESS  
Memorializes Congress to appropriate additional money for increased seafood testing

HCR 47 JONES JUVENILES  
Requests the office of juvenile justice to study the impacts of COVID-19 on its operations

**House Concurrent Resolutions to be Adopted Subject to Call**

HCR 66 BISHOP, S. TAX/CORP FRANCHISE  
Suspends the lower tier of the corporation franchise tax levied on domestic and foreign corporations and the initial tax levied on certain business entities subject to the corporate franchise tax

**House Concurrent Resolutions 3rd Reading and Final Passage**

HCR 2 MAGEE CRIMINAL/JUSTICE  
Suspends certain provisions of the Code of Criminal Procedure relative to financial obligations of criminal offenders

**House Bills 3rd Reading and Final Passage**

HB 81 TURNER ETHICS/NEPOTISM  
Provides an exception to allow immediate family members of a coach of a collegiate athletic program to be employed on the staff of that program

HB 132 HORTON TIME/DAYLIGHT SAVING  
Adopts daylight saving time as the standard time

HB 371 TURNER ATHLETICS  
Provides relative to the comprehensive sports injury management program for student athletics

HB 449 ECHOLS HEALTH SERVICES  
Provides relative to behavioral health services delivered via telehealth

HB 682 FRIEMAN INSURANCE  
Provides relative to reserves for insurers

HB 798 DWIGHT PUBLIC MEETINGS  
Authorizes public bodies to allow members to participate and vote electronically during certain states of emergency subject to certain conditions

HB 819 BAGLEY MEDICAL MARIJUANA  
Authorizes the recommendation of medical marijuana for additional conditions and allows any state-licensed physician to recommend medical marijuana

HB 202 HORTON REVENUE DEPARTMENT  
Provides that the reports, studies, and recommended publications of the Louisiana Tax Institute shall be distributed by the Department of Revenue rather than the Department of State and provides for the membership of the board of the Institute

HB 213 MIGUEZ MUSEUMS  
Provides relative to the Louisiana Military Hall of Fame and Museum

HB 328 FREEMAN TAX/SALES-USE, LOCAL-EXEM  
Authorizes an exemption from local sales taxes for feminine hygiene products and diapers

HB 4 BACALA RETIREMENT/PAROCHIAL EMP  
Provides relative to the frequency of plan experience studies for the Parochial Employees' Retirement System of Louisiana

HB 8 BOURRIQUE RETIREMENT/TEACHERS  
Provides relative to the rehire of retired teachers in the Teachers' Retirement System of Louisiana as substitute classroom teachers

HB 11 CARPENTER RETIREMENT/FIREFIGHTERS  
Provides relative to benefit payments if an eligible member of the Firefighters' Retirement System dies prior to retirement

HB 12 CARPENTER RETIREMENT/FIREFIGHTERS  
Provides relative to the suspension of benefits of members of the Firefighters' Retirement System upon reemployment
