Senate Resolutions 2nd Reading

- SR 68 JOHNS SENATE
Directs the executive branch agencies and entities under the jurisdictional oversight of the Senate Committee on Commerce, Consumer Protection and International Affairs to continue to submit statutorily mandated reports until such time as the mandate is specifically amended or repealed.
- SR 69 CARTER, TROY GOVERNOR
Requests the governor to issue an executive order requiring persons over age two to wear a mask or cloth face covering and authorizes business operators and building owners to deny admittance to individuals over age two who fail to wear a mask or cloth face covering.

Provides relative to addresses to where absentee by mail ballots are sent. (gov sig)
- SB 80 CARTER, TROY SCHOOLS
Exempts interior blueprints and floor plans of public school buildings and facilities from the definition of "public records". (gov sig)
- SB 104 MILLIGAN MUSEUMS
Provides for board membership and authority of certain state museums. (gov sig)
- SB 204 TALBOT INSURANCE POLICIES
Provides for health insurance coverage of cancer treatments. (gov sig)
- SB 218 CLOUD ELECTED OFFICIALS
Requires that completion of qualifying forms for elected office shall include submission of valid identification. (8/1/20)
- SB 238 ALLAIN CAMPAIGN FINANCE
Provides for repayment of personal contributions or loans. (8/1/20)
- SB 272 ABRAHAM TAX EXEMPTIONS
Constitutional amendment to establish an ad valorem tax exemption for property subject to a cooperative endeavor agreement requiring the property owner to make payments in lieu of taxes. (2/3 - CA13s1(A))
- SB 300 JACKSON GAMING
Provides relative to the Charitable Raffles, Bingo, and Keno Licensing Law. (gov sig)
- SB 334 ALLAIN REVENUE DEPARTMENT
Provides for the funding of the operations of the Department of Revenue. (2/3 - CA7s2.1(A)) (See Act)
- SB 344 JOHNS GOVERNMENTAL REGULATIONS
Provides relative to the regulation of battery-charged fences by parishes and municipalities. (8/1/20)
- SB 351 CATHEY POLITICAL PARTIES
Allows each recognized political party to determine the composition of its state central committee. (gov sig)
- SB 365 CLOUD STUDENTS
Requires that information be provided to students about high-demand, high-wage jobs during the development and revision of their individual graduation plans. (gov sig)
- SB 395 CLOUD ADVERTISING
Provides relative to false, misleading, or deceptive advertising. (8/1/20)
- SB 396 ABRAHAM TAX/AD VALOREM
Authorizes and provides for cooperative endeavor agreements between local governmental subdivisions and other entities that may require payments in lieu of ad valorem taxes. (See Act)

- HCR 20 WHITE, M SCHOOLS/BUS OPERATORS
Requests that the State Bd. of Elementary and Secondary Education study the compensation schedule for school bus operators
- HCR 29 JAMES CRIMINAL/RECORDS
Creates the Clean Slate Task Force
- HCR 33 FREIBERG EDUCATION
Requests the Board of Regents, Department of Revenue, Louisiana Workforce Commission, and office of student financial assistance to collaborate to study the trajectory of Louisiana's postsecondary graduates
- HCR 35 LACOMBE WATER/RESOURCES
Extends the False River Watershed Council
- HCR 61 RISER WILDLIFE & FISHERIES
Urges and requests the Department of Wildlife and Fisheries to review the restrictions on possession of exotic and invasive species
- HCR 62 HODGES FLOODING/CONTROL
Continues the Comite River Diversion Canal Project Task Force
- HCR 63 HODGES WATERWAYS/RESERVOIRS
Urges and requests the division of administration, office of community development, to consider funding the Darlington Reservoir
- HCR 64 ZERINGUE WATERWAYS
To express support for the annual Gulf Hypoxia Mapping Cruise conducted by the Louisiana Universities Marine Consortium and to memorialize congress to provide continued funding
- HCR 81 MARCELLE WORKFORCE DEVELOPMENT
Establishes a task force to study and make recommendations relative to the cannabis industry projected workforce demands
- HCR 92 PIERRE COLLEGES/COMMUNITY AND TECHNICAL
Urges and requests the Louisiana Community and Technical College System to pilot a regional approach for the delivery of commercial driver's license training and certification
- HCR 3 MAGEE BOARDS/COMMISSIONS
Recreates the Louisiana Commission on Justice System Funding
- HCR 53 STAGNI EXCEPTIONAL PERSONS
Requests a study concerning a voluntary registry of persons with autism and other developmental disabilities for use by law enforcement professionals
- HCR 75 SCHEXNAYDER WORKFORCE DEVELOPMENT
Requests the Workforce Investment Council and Occupational Forecasting Conference to immediately work with private sector experts to assess short-term and long-term workforce implications and opportunities resulting from COVID-19
- HCR 80 SCHEXNAYDER UNEMPLOYMENT COMP
Requests the Louisiana Workforce Commission to provide clear, consistent, and easily accessible explanations of unemployment benefits and potential ramifications
- HCR 93 CREWS GOVERNOR
Directs the governor to ensure that individual liberty and rights are protected as the state administers contact tracing

- HCR 50 GREEN INSURANCE/HEALTH
Requests the Department of Insurance to study and report on the status of health insurance benefits relative to postpartum diastasis recti, pelvic floor dysfunction, and breast reduction

Creates a task force to study how to best capitalize on Louisiana's international trade potential

Authorizes and directs suspension of licensing fees imposed on businesses by state agencies and licensing boards

Provides relative to qualified truck stop facilities
- HB 411 RISER HUNTING/LICENSES
Provides relative to hunting and fishing license fees for Purple Heart recipients
- HB 417 JAMES JUVENILE PROCEDURE
Provides relative to the waiver of certain court costs and fees

Provides relative to motions to modify disposition
