SR 70 CARTER, TROY GOVERNOR  
Request the governor to issue an executive order requiring certain persons to wear a face covering in public under certain conditions and authorizing businesses to deny admittance to persons without face coverings.

Requests DOTD to determine which of its assets are available for broadband internet lines and to implement a "Dig Once" policy allowing broadband internet operators to install cable in the ground.

SCR 56 HEWITT FISH/FISHING  
Requests CPRA and the Dept. of Wildlife and Fisheries to cooperate in developing projects and programs to enhance the oyster industry.

SCR 61 HEWITT ABORTION  
Recognizes May 2020 as Louisiana Abortion Recovery Awareness Month and commends pro-life groups for their service to women suffering from abortion related trauma.

SCR 67 FOIL FLOODS/FLOODING  
Requests that local governmental subdivisions consider manufactured home chassis elevation when setting requirements for freeboard purposes.

Creates and provides for the Community Drinking Water Infrastructure Sustainability Act. (8/1/20)

SB 202 TALBOT INSURANCE POLICIES  
Provides for health insurance coverage for participants in clinical trials. (8/1/20)

SB 293 JACKSON EDUCATION ACCOUNTABILITY  
Limits the use of certain test scores in the school accountability system. (gov sig)

SB 299 JACKSON INSURANCE RATES  
Prohibits insurers from using certain criteria for rate setting. (8/1/20)

SB 359 HENSGENS COASTAL RESOURCES  
Provides for the enforcement of coastal use permits. (gov sig)
