Requires in-service training for teachers and certain other school personnel on adverse childhood experiences and trauma-informed education. (gov sig)

SB 215 BARROW DISCRIMINATION
Provides for the reasonable accommodations of employees who become temporarily disabled due to certain medical conditions. (8/1/21)

SB 216 MILLS, ROBERT TEACHERS
Requires early literacy professional development for certain teachers. (gov sig)

SB 225 REESE UNEMPLOYMENT COMP
Provides relative to unemployment insurance. (See Act)

SB 234 MCMATH SCHOOLS
Provides relative to expanded academic support. (8/1/21)

SB 238 MILLIGAN SCHOOLS
Provides with respect to the Caddo Educational Excellence Fund. (gov sig)

Provides relative to required orientation and training of new registrars of voters

Repeals reporting requirements related to commercial motor vehicle policies

Provides relative to the leasing of the 4.9 GHz band
