Senate Resolutions 2nd Reading

- SR 217 FESI HEALTH CARE
Directs the Louisiana Department of Health and the LSU Health Services Center - New Orleans, health care services division, to report on the use and results of hydroxychloroquine on Medicaid patients for treating COVID-19.
- SR 218 LAMBERT COMMENDATIONS
Commends Jeffrey Ditman 2020-2021 on being named Teacher of the Year at Lutchter High School from District 18.
- SR 219 LAMBERT COMMENDATIONS
Commends Becky Louque for being named the St. James Parish School System's 2020-2021 Principal of the Year.

Senate Resolutions 2nd Reading Subject to Call

- SR 190 BOUDREAUX TRANSPORTATION/DEV DEPT
Requests the Department of Transportation and Development to study the length and danger of longer freight trains.
- SR 207 WHITE, B FISCAL CONTROLS
Authorizes the establishment of a subcommittee of the Committee on Finance to study Louisiana Workforce Commission administration of the federal unemployment compensation program.
- SR 209 PETERSON CONGRESS
Memorializes Congress to enact federal legislation granting statehood to the people of Washington, D.C.

Urges and requests the La. Department of Health to convene a healthcare workplace violence task force to advance the priorities expressed in HCR No. 60 of the 2019 R.S.

Continues the Unemployment Compensation and Trust Fund Task Force
- HCR 125 WRIGHT CONTRACTS
Directs a joint subcommittee to study certain contractual restrictions on the practice of medicine

- SCR 30 ALLAIN JOINT RULES
Limits annual total cash general obligation capital outlay projects to general obligation bond cash line of credit capacity.
- SCR 74 MORRIS, JAY CLERKS OF COURT
Creates a task force to study the electronic filing of public documents with the clerk of court of Ouachita Parish.

Senate Bills 3rd Reading and Final Passage Subject to Call

SB 1 PEACOCK TAX/SALES
Phases in the dedication of the temporary state sales tax levy to the Transportation Trust Fund. (8/1/21)

SB 19 MORRIS, JAY IMMOVABLE PROPERTY
Provides relative to partition of immovable property under certain circumstances. (8/1/21)

SB 22 PEACOCK RETIREMENT BENEFITS
Provides relative to retirement eligibility for certain members of state retirement systems and for disability retirement. (6/30/21)

SB 44 PETERSON ENVIRONMENT QUALITY DEPT
Provides for reporting and notification of releases of certain materials that cause an emergency condition. (8/1/21)

SB 85 ABRAHAM CRIMINAL JUSTICE
Provides relative to the rate at which certain prisoners earn "good time". (gov sig)

SB 115 PEACOCK CRIME/PUNISHMENT
Prohibits possession of firearms, ammunition, or electric weapons or devices by certain felons. (8/1/21)

SB 175 ALLAIN TAX/FRANCHISE/CORPORATE
Provides for a single rate of corporation franchise tax. (See Act)

HCR 89 MARCELLE CORRECTIONAL FACILITIES
Requests a study of the health and safety conditions of Louisiana prisons and jails

HCR 97 JONES PARDON/PAROLE
Requests a study of case law and best practices to better understand other approaches to parole

HCR 6 ZERINGUE FUNDS/FUNDING-BUDGET, ST
Directs flood protection districts and parish governing authorities in areas benefitting from the federal Hurricane and Storm Damage Risk Reduction System (HSDRRS) to contribute towards the \$400 million annual payments the state must make for this project

HCR 92 DAVIS PROPERTY/COMMUNITY
Requests the Louisiana State Law Institute to study provisions of law on partition of community property

HB 40 WRIGHT FUNDS/FUNDING
Limits certain monies from being used to pay for certain Dept. of Transportation and Development expenses

HB 274 BISHOP, S. TAX/INCOME TAX
(Constitutional Amendment) Provides for the rates and brackets for purposes of calculating income taxes and limits the mandatory deduction for federal income taxes paid to corporate income taxes

HB 276 BEAULLIEU BUDGETARY CONTROLS
Provides for changes in the expenditure limit calculation

HB 297 TARVER, PHILLIP COURTS/MAYORS
Provides relative to mayor's courts providing notice

HB 393 ORGERON ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES
Allows any wine producer or manufacturer to sell sparkling and still wine on or off premises and ship directly to a consumer

HB 416 HODGES CURRICULA
Requires instruction regarding World War II and the Holocaust for high school students and training for teachers relative to such instruction

HB 443 BEAULLIEU TAX/INCOME-CREDIT
Provides for individual income tax credits for donations made to school tuition organizations
