7. **HB367** **BRASS** **SCHOOLS/EMPLOYEES** Requires teachers or other school employees placed on administrative leave during a law enforcement investigation to remain on leave at least until the completion of the investigation by the law enforcement agency

8. **HB384** **WHEAT** **HEALTH CARE/FACILITIES** Requires pediatric day health care facilities to provide for installation and operation of cameras at their premises

9. **HB398** **DUPLESSIS** **ENVIRONMENT/ENFORCEMENT** Increases the maximum civil penalties assessed by the Department of Environmental Quality

10. **HB423** **MINCEY** **VOTING/REGISTRATION** Requires public school governing authorities to provide high school seniors the opportunity to register to vote

11. **HB516** **LANDRY** **EDUCATION** Requires each governing authority of a public high school to adopt policies regarding attendance, breastfeeding, and child care for students who are pregnant or parenting
