1. **HB47**            **EDMONSTON**            **VACCINES/VACCINATION** Requires that any communication issued to students or parents relative to immunization requirements include exemption information and an exemption form
  
2. **HB195**           **FREEMAN**            **SCHOOLS** Requires public schools to provide free menstrual products in student restrooms or other easily accessible locations
  
3. **HB214**           **NELSON**            **TEACHERS/CERTIFICATION** Requires passage of a reading instruction test as a condition of teacher certification in elementary education

9. **HB398**           **DUPLESSIS**           **ENVIRONMENT/ENFORCEMENT** Increases the maximum civil penalties assessed by the Department of Environmental Quality
  
10. **HB423**           **MINCEY**            **VOTING/REGISTRATION** Requires public school governing authorities to provide high school seniors the opportunity to register to vote
  
11. **HB516**           **LANDRY**            **EDUCATION** Requires each governing authority of a public high school to adopt policies regarding attendance, breastfeeding, and child care for students who are pregnant or parenting
