SR 60 JACKSON INSURANCE DEPARTMENT  
Requests the Department of Insurance to create a task force to study the causes of infertility in women and mandating insurance coverage of fertility treatments for women.

SB 334 JACKSON CRIMINAL RECORDS  
Provides for attempted malfeasance in office convictions to be set aside and expunged. (8/1/22)

SB 338 JACKSON CRIMINAL PROCEDURE  
Provides relative to responsive verdicts. (8/1/22)

SB 353 FIELDS COURTS  
Provides relative to the judgeships of the second district of the First Circuit Court of Appeal. (2/3 - CA5s9) (gov sig)

SB 462 WARD PUBLIC CONTRACTS  
Authorizes public entities to enter into public-private partnerships. (gov sig)
