Senate Resolutions 2nd Reading

- SR 186 PEACOCK COMMENDATIONS
Commends the two hundred thirty-fifth anniversary of the ratification of the U.S. Constitution and the annual luncheon by the Shreveport Chapter of the Daughters of the American Revolution.
- SR 187 DUPLESSIS SPECIAL DAY/WEEK/MONTH
Recognizes June 26, 2023, as National HIV Testing Awareness Day in support of the efforts of the federal government in ending the HIV epidemic in the state of Louisiana.

- SR 174 BARROW CONGRESS
Memorializes the U.S. Congress to assist with a La. pilot program for the recruitment of new members to the U.S. Army.

Memorializes the U.S. Congress to assist with a Louisiana pilot program for the recruitment of new members to the U.S. Army.

Provides for balance billing by and reimbursement of covered health services provided by out-of-network emergency ambulance services. (8/1/23)
- SB 137 BARROW CHILDREN
Creates the Office of the State Child Ombudsman and the state child ombudsman. (8/1/23)
- SB 159 CATHEY JUVENILE JUSTICE
Provides for the detention of seventeen year old juveniles under certain circumstances. (gov sig)
- SB 162 MCMATH COMMERCIAL REGULATIONS
Creates the Secure Online Child Interaction and Age Limitation Act. (8/1/23)
- SB 185 REESE COMMERCIAL REGULATIONS
Provides relative to the licensing and regulation of virtual businesses. (8/1/23)
- SB 188 STINE HEALTH/ACC INSURANCE
Provides for utilization review and approval procedures of claims for healthcare provider services. (gov sig)
- SB 207 MILLIGAN SCHOOLS
Creates the School Safety Act of 2023. (gov sig)

- SB 214 MCMATH ECONOMIC DEVELOP DEPT
Renames and reorganizes the Department of Economic Development as the Department of Commerce, moves the office of multimodal commerce from the Department of Transportation and Development to the Department of Commerce, and transfers powers, duties, and responsibilities with respect to multimodal commerce and corresponding department employees, equipment, facilities, funding, and statutory entities from the Department of Transportation and Development to the Department of Commerce. (7/1/24)
- SB 217 HENRY, CAMERON CRIME/PUNISHMENT
Creates a state wide database for individuals convicted of child abuse/neglect. (7/1/24)

- SR 133 DUPLESSIS JUVENILES
Requests the Orleans Parish Juvenile Services Financing District be duly appointed by their appointing authorities and thereafter organize itself and create a plan to adequately fund juvenile justice services and requests the City of New Orleans to take urgent action to implement the plan.
- SR 151 DUPLESSIS WEAPONS
Requests Louisiana State Police, LDH's office of behavioral health, and the Louisiana Commission on Law Enforcement to collaborate on best practices and model programs that address gun violence prevention and intervention.
- SR 161 CLOUD INDIAN AFFAIRS
Reestablishes the Task Force on State Recognition of Indian Tribes.
- SR 166 CLOUD JUVENILE JUSTICE
Requests the office of juvenile justice in the Department of Public Safety and Corrections to submit quarterly reports to the Senate regarding the progress and implementation of the tiered juvenile justice system established by Act No. 693 of the 2022 Regular Session of the Louisiana Legislature.
- SR 168 MIZELL JUVENILE JUSTICE
Creates the Task Force for Juvenile Justice Facility Standards.
- SR 169 MIZELL ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES
Requests the commissioner of the office of alcohol and tobacco control, Department of Revenue, to submit a written report concerning the sale or service of alcoholic beverages to underage persons.
- SR 170 DUPLESSIS CRIME/PUNISHMENT
Creates a task force to study and make recommendations regarding crime against nature by solicitation.

Re-establishes the Lower Pearl River Basin Task Force.

Recreates the Louisiana Public Defender Optimal Funding Group to study and make recommendations regarding the feasibility of establishing an optimal funding mechanism for the Louisiana Public Defender Board.
