1. **SB276** **PRESSLY** **CRIME/PUNISHMENT** Creates the crime of coerced criminal abortion by means of fraud to prohibit a third-party from knowingly using an abortion-inducing drug to cause, or attempt to cause, an abortion on an unsuspecting pregnant mother without her knowledge or consent and amends various abortion criminal laws to add the crime of attempted abortion. 5. **SB369** **BASS** **INSURANCE COMMISSIONER** Provides venue options for insurance fraud and for the allocation of the insurance fraud assessment fund. (See Act)
6. **SB463** **WHEAT** **DENTAL HEALTH** Creates the Louisiana Dental Loss Ratios for Dental Healthcare Services Plans Act. (1/1/25)
7. **SB88** **CONNICK** **TAX/TAXATION** Authorizes creation of a tax increment financing district for parishes of a certain size for economic development purposes. (gov sig)

19. **SB406** **KLEINPETER** **RETIREMENT BENEFITS** Removes the cap on the amount of any permanent benefit increase for recipients whose benefit is based on the record of someone who retired with at least 30 years of service credit. (gov sig)
20. **SB415** **PRICE** **SHERIFFS PEN/RELIEF FUND** Provides for reemployment of retirees of the Louisiana Sheriffs' Pension and Relief Fund. (gov sig)
