- SB 181 FOIL CHARITABLE GAMING
Provides an exemption for nonprofit healthcare organizations to hold and operate a license for conducting certain raffles. (8/1/26)
- SB 199 SEABAUGH CRIME/PUNISHMENT
Imposes mandatory minimum sentences for a second offense of purchasing commercial sexual activity and second and subsequent offenses of soliciting for prostitutes. (8/1/26)
- SB 200 HODGES HOMELAND SECURITY
Allows for expropriation of land near military bases that is owned by foreign adversaries or agents of foreign adversaries when the ownership poses a threat to public health and safety. (gov sig)

Provides 10-year time limitation on prosecution of certain crimes committed by elected officials and public employees. (8/1/26)
