SB 140 MILLER, G. CIVIL PROCEDURE  
Provides for multiple successions in the same proceeding. (8/1/26)

SB 141 MORRIS, JAY COURTS  
Provides that activities of the Integrated Criminal Justice Information System Policy Board be performed by the supreme court. (gov sig)

SB 152 FESI FOOD SAFETY  
Prohibits certain actions with respect to cell cultured food products for human consumption. (8/1/26)

SB 207 MIGUEZ CRIMINAL PROCEDURE  
Provides 10-year time limitation on prosecution of certain crimes committed by elected officials and public employees. (8/1/26)

SB 210 KLEINPETER ELECTIONS DEPARTMENT  
Provides for the increase in the number of election commissioners for closed party primaries. (8/1/26)

SB 246 LUNEAU HEALTH/ACC INSURANCE  
Establishes requirements for health insurance issuers using artificial intelligence or automated decision systems. (8/1/26)

SB 292 STINE GOVERNOR  
Provides for the office and duties of the office of the state inspector general. (gov sig)
